



March is Reading Month Vocabulary Word Parade Tuesday, March 21, 2017

Randolph will be hosting a vocabulary word parade as part of our March is Reading month celebration on **Tuesday, March 21st from 2:00pm-2:30pm**. This parade is designed for our students to foster the enjoyment of reading and writing and hopefully learn some new vocabulary words.

At home students are encouraged to do any of the options below for participation in the parade.

Small-

Choose a word and draw an appropriate description/illustration of the word on a poster or sign. Be sure to neatly print the vocabulary word in big letters on the poster or sign.

Medium-

Choose a word and make cardboard, paperbag, or material "puppet" for the chosen word to carry in the parade. Or make a hat using various materials illustrating the word. Be sure to neatly print the vocabulary word in big letters on the puppet/hat, or on paper to carry or pin on your shirt.

Large-

Choose a vocabulary word and dress in/make a full costume illustrating the word. Be sure to neatly print the vocabulary word in big letters to pin on your costume or carry in the parade.

Remember to neatly print the vocabulary word in big letters somewhere on or near your poster, puppet, hat or costume. You can pin it to your shirt or wear it around your neck, but the word must be visible and readable!
